I am extremely delighted to share the news that OOB is ranked amongst the top 20 performing schools in Assessment of Scholastic Skills through Educational Testing (ASSET) 2021-22. Jeon Johnson of Grade 9 and Jershom Renjith of Grade 5 made us proud as they emerged UAE toppers in English and Science respectively. They were felicitated in a glittering ceremony at the Educational Initiatives ASSET Awards 2022. With a total of 660 students ranked among the top performers, 53 students emerged with an 'Outstanding' performance, 211 students at 'Distinguished' level, and 396 students were rated at the 'Creditable' level. 462 students from grades 5 to 8 qualified for the ASSET Talent Search assessment. These students competed against all ASSET-taking students across UAE and scored in the top 15%. Kudos to the teachers and pupils of OOB family on this stupendous achievement!

The recipient of the 'Sharjah Green Award', OOB is committed to a pioneering model of environment and sustainability practices.
