





For in their eyes, we find our way, A light that never fades to gray. In friendship's arms, we rise and soar, Together always, evermore.





- 1/2 cup yogurt 3.
- 1 small onion (chopped) 4.
- 1 small tomato (chopped) 5.
- 6. Grated carrot
- 1 green chili (optional) 7.
- Fresh coriander (chopped) 8.
- Salt to taste 9.
- Oil for cooking 10.



Instructions:

- 1. Grind the oats into a powder. Mix with semolina, yogurt, and water to make a thick batter.
- 2. Add chopped onion, tomato, carrot, chili, coriander, and salt to the batter.
- 3. Heat a non-stick pan, spread a little oil, and pour a ladle of the batter to make a small uttapam.
- 4. Cook on both sides until golden and serve with chutney or ketchup.


